



# PADI ADVANCED REBREATHER DIVER

## 3 Days



The Advanced Rebreather Diver Course adds to your Rebreather Diver skills by qualifying you to safely dive down to 30m (or 40m if qualified as a PADI Deep Diver). The course will explain the need for and demonstrate the use of additional equipment required for diving deeper than 18m.

### Who can do the course?

The minimum you need to start the course is:

- PADI Open Water Diver (you can complete your Advanced Open Water Diver Course at the same time).
- PADI Rebreather Diver or equivalent.
- 30 logged dives.
- 18 years old.

### What's involved?

The three parts of the course are:

- Knowledge Development and Practical Application: You will need to complete the last two chapters of the manual. This is where we discuss dive planning and how to overcome the potential hazards of diving deeper on a rebreather. We will also spend time rigging and configuring additional equipment required for diving deeper than 18m.
- Pool Session: This a review of the skills learnt during the Rebreather Diver course whilst incorporating the additional equipment used during deep diving.
- Four Open Water Training Dives: The focus of the course is on diving during which we will be diving progressively deeper. This will give you an opportunity to become comfortable with all your equipment whilst applying skills developed during the pool session.
