



PADI REBREATHER DIVER

4 Days



The PADI Rebreather Diver course is your first step to becoming a recreational rebreather diver. This entry-level course gives you the foundational knowledge and skills to safely dive the Poseidon Discovery Rebreather to a maximum depth of 18m.

Who can do the course?

The minimum you need to start the course is:

- PADI Open Water Diver or equivalent.
- PADI Enriched Aid Diver or equivalent.
- 25 logged dives.
- 18 years old.

What's involved?

The course may be separated into three parts:

- Knowledge Development and Practical Application: This is a combination of some pre-study, classroom sessions and “dry” workshops. The pre-study involves reading and answering questions from the student manual (only the first three chapters of the manual) and the classroom sessions involve reviewing the questions you answered and further developing your knowledge. The workshops involve assembling and testing the equipment ready for diving and basic maintenance including cleaning the equipment for subsequent dives or storage.
- Pool Session: This is where we introduce the specific skills to safely dive the rebreather and to adapt your open circuit skills to rebreather diving.
- Five Open Water Training Dives: We apply and further develop the skills learnt in the pool to real open water situations.
