

REBREATHER QUALIFIER 3 Days



As more recreational rebreathers become available you will be able to easily crossover to other units. Currently the only recreational rebreather is the Poseidon Discovery but if you are currently qualified on another rebreather you can crossover to the Discovery rebreather as it is currently the most readily available unit to hire either in the UK or abroad giving you greater opportunities to dive on a rebreather.

Who can do this course?

- A qualified Rebreather Diver and/or Advanced Rebreather Diver
- A rebreather diver, certified by a recognised training organisation, who is qualified to dive either a recreational or technical unit. Additional training may be required.

What's involved?

- Knowledge Review: This portion refreshes the information learnt during the Rebreather Diver and Advanced Rebreather Diver courses (for those crossing over from other training agencies additional knowledge development may be required) and we focus on the specific aspects of the recreational rebreather.
- Practical Application: This is where we focus on the specific information and skills relating to the new rebreather, for example assembly, disassembly, pre-dive checks and maintenance.
- One Pool Session: During this session we focus on the specific skills required to safely dive the new rebreather.
- Open Water Dives: There are four training dives for the Rebreather Diver and an additional dive for the Advanced Rebreather Diver. This will give you plenty of time to adapt to the particular characteristics of the new rebreather.
