



PADI INTEGRATED REBREATHING & ADVANCED REBREATHING DIVER

5/6 Days

For divers who are limited by time but would like to complete both courses then the integrated option reduces the number of open water training dives from nine to seven (saving about a day) without reducing the total dive times or skills.

Who can do the course?

The minimum you need to start the course is:

- Be certified as a PADI Advanced Open Water and Enriched Air Diver or equivalent.
- Be at least 18 years old.
- Have logged at least 30dives.

What's involved?

- Knowledge Development and Practical Application Session: You will need to read the whole manual and complete all the knowledge reviews. The practical application sessions are combined together from the two courses in a logical sequence.
- One Pool Session: The pool session combines all the skills from the Rebreather and Advanced Rebreather courses and you will be carrying a bailout cylinder during the session.
- Seven Open Water Training Dives: Some of the dives are combined which cuts down on the overall number of dives but not the learning experience. Again you will be diving with a bailout cylinder from the beginning.
